Please Note

- 'Standard' will be updated each term utilising current reports.
- Standards for students are determined by the Year Coordinator, in conjunction with the Leadership team & CATT case managers, considering individual circumstances.
- Behavioural transgressions (as per Student Code of Conduct) may impact a student's Standard.
- Students can apply for a review of their standard at key times throughout a term, at the discretion of the Year Coordinator & Head of Department / Year Level Deputy.
- Reviews, at the request of a student, will occur following the completion of a negotiated 4-week engagement contract.
- Students returning from suspension will have their Standard reviewed at the end of a negotiated 4-week engagement contract.
- All reviews will consider student's individual circumstances and if necessary, include support staff.
- The student must take responsibility for managing the review paperwork unless support is required as per the student's individual circumstances.
- This document may be referenced in order to determine a student's ability to participate Co / Extra-Curricular events such as Formals, Year Level Camps, School Sports etc.; Students not at Standard will have the opportunity to discuss and show cause as to their ability to participate
- Year Co-Ordinators, Head of Department or Deputy Principals may request Staff feedback, when in reviewing a student's standard.
